'Alamo' Switchgrass  
'Aztec' Maximillian Sunflower  
'Borden' Sand Dropseed  
'Comanche' Partridge Pea  
'Cuero' Purple Prairie Clover  
'Duck Creek' Texas Dropseed  
'Earl' Big Bluestem  
'Eldorado' Engelmann Daisy  
'Haskell' Sideoats Grama  
'Hondo' Velvet Bundleflower  
'Lometa' Indiangrass  
'Mason' Sand Lovegrass  
'OK Select' Little Bluestem  
'Plains' Prairie Acacia  
'Plateau' Bush Sunflower  
'Sabine' Illinois Bundleflower  
'San Marcos' Eastern Gamagrass  
'Van Horn' Green Sprangletop

The above listed species would be more than enough diversity to start a prairie. From an economic standpoint, this is probably the least expensive option. Other species can be overseeded later on.
